
The Fighting Around Boston, 1773–1776

- **3.** What movements on April 18, 1775, are shown? What events took place on the day following these movements?
- **4.** Describe the route the British traveled to get to Concord. Describe the route Paul Revere and William Dawes took.
- 5. What prompted the British evacuation of Boston? When did this occur?
- **6. Critical Thinking: Location** Study the map and locate the Powder House, where the colonial militia stored its gunpowder. Next, determine where British troops were concentrated before April 1775. Why might the militia have chosen to maintain the Powder House at that location?
